



Grant Program Invites 'Healthy Forests' Proposals

The Sierra Nevada Conservancy has opened the solicitation period for its \$5 million "Healthy Forests" grant program.

Applicants have until Oct. 21 to submit pre-application documents. All projects must be designed to benefit Sierra Nevada forests and associated meadows. The projects can reduce the risk of impacts from wildfires or preserve or restore ecosystem functions.

Public agencies, nonprofit organizations and federally recognized tribes are encouraged to apply. Officials will review the pre-applications and invite applicants with viable projects to submit full applications.
