### Sierra Nevada Geotourism map guide goes live...



With the travel season looming many Californians will be headed to the Sierra.

And they will be deeply interested in a new resource available in that pursuit.

It's called the Sierra Nevada Geotourism MapGuide. The guide - which can be accessed online at [www.SierraNevadaGeoTourism.org](http://www.SierraNevadaGeoTourism.org) is a partnership between National Geographic, the Sierra Business Council and the Sierra Nevada Conservancy, along with hundreds of local residents.

The site includes more than 1,300 recommendations from hundreds of Sierra Nevada "locals" seeking to share their favorite places in the Sierra with visitors.

In that realm the guide offers info on bed and breakfast inns, scenic vistas, Sierra wineries, historic sites, cultural events, recreation spots and other points of interest placed on the Sierra MapGuide by local residents.

Accessible on the site is a new print map featuring 250 MapGuide destinations, replete with photos, travel tips, scenic highways, topographic features, and a QR scan code to connect smart phones to the Web site.
